**May 2, 2006 Awards Ceremony**

**GROWING SUCCESS**

- In 1990, four scholarships were awarded. The value of the scholarships that year totaled \$5,000.
- In 2006, 201 scholarships were awarded. The value of the scholarships in 2006 totaled approximately \$136,000.
- To date, **\$1,214,425** has been awarded in scholarships since the start of the C-I Dollars for Scholars Foundation.
- The Cambridge-Isanti Dollars for Scholars Phonathon was initiated in 1994. That year, the student callers raised \$2,066.
- In 2006, the Phonathon student callers raised over \$21,000.
- To date, over **\$253,000** has been raised by the Phonathon student callers.
- Since our start in 1990, our donors have given out **1,754 scholarships** to Cambridge-Isanti students.

## THANK YOU DOROTHY MUNKBERG

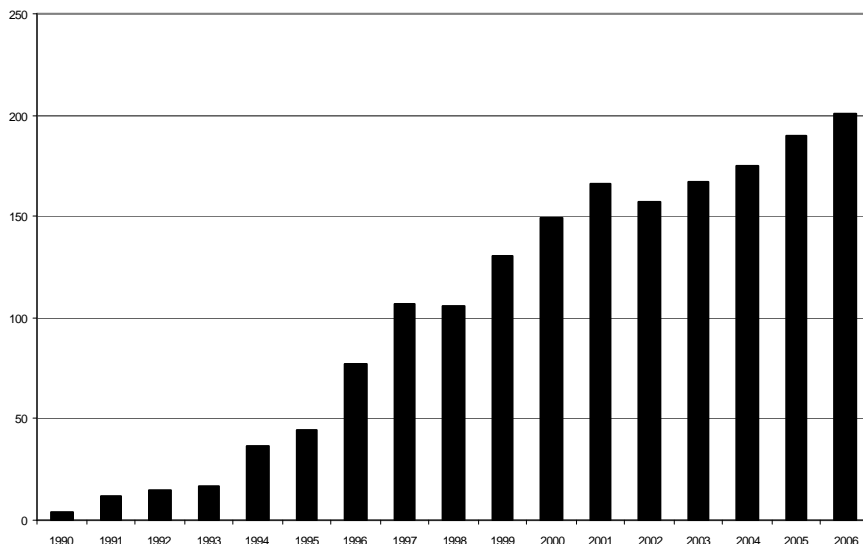

A plaque and certificate of appreciation from the Cambridge-Isanti Dollars for Scholars Foundation will be presented to her **"In Appreciation for Outstanding Commitment and Dedicated Service"** from 1990-2007 at this year's senior awards ceremony.

Dorothy and her family established the very first scholarship given by the foundation in 1989, the Delmer E. Munkberg Memorial Scholarship. Throughout the years she was a very active board member, always willing to tackle the next project, as well as doing the everyday work that needed doing. She served as treasurer and bookkeeper for many years and was the chapter historian, diligently preserving Dollars for Scholars newspaper clippings and other memorabilia. ## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Awarded \$136,100 in Dollars for Scholars scholarships in 2006 compared to \$124,850 in 2005. The number of scholarships awarded was 201 compared to 190 in 2005.
- 34 students received scholarships to attend ARCC-Cambridge Campus.
- Endowment reached \$758,344, up from \$684,049 in 2005.
- Phonathon pledges for 2006 were \$21,725 compared to 2005 at \$20,160.
