**GROWING SUCCESS**

- In 1990, four scholarships were awarded. The value of the scholarships that year totaled \$5,000.
- In 2008, 216 scholarships were awarded. The value of the scholarships in 2008 totaled approximately \$152,000.
- To date, **\$1,505,600** has been awarded in scholarships since the start of the C-I Dollars for Scholars Foundation.
- The Cambridge-Isanti Dollars for Scholars Phonathon was initiated in 1994. That year, the student callers raised \$2,066.
- In 2008, the Phonathon student callers raised over \$23,000.
- To date, almost **\$300,000** has been raised by the Phonathon student callers.
- Since our start in 1990, our donors have awarded **2,076 scholarships** to Cambridge-Isanti students.

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Awarded \$152,200 in Dollars for Scholars scholarships, compared to \$138,975 in 2007. The number of recipients was 216 compared to 200 in 2007.
- 38 students received \$26,850 in scholarships to attend AARC – Cambridge Campus.
- Endowment funds (*used for permanent scholarships*) reached \$591,197 up from \$553,986 in 2007.
